

Saving Money For Charters

Our below-market loan and lease rates have saved schools more than \$18.6 million in interest payments.

If your facility needs financing, we'll get it for you at the lowest cost.

Working with impact-minded lenders and investors, we can help your school purchase land for a new facility, renovate an existing facility, or secure and/or guarantee a lease or loan on a facility. Since 2003, we have provided charter schools across the country with more than \$295 million in loans and credit enhancements.

FINANCING WE OFFER

Building Hope's status as a nonprofit organization, along with the trust we have built with lenders, enables us to provide loans and credit enhancements at belowmarket rates. We work with both existing and new schools. Our goal is to provide the highest quality at the lowest cost.

Direct Lending

Building Hope provides both senior and subordinated loans for a period of up to 25 years. Typically, we obtain a security interest in the property being financed or seek another type of collateral to secure the loan. Many of our transactions involve multiple lenders where Building Hope provides the last dollars needed to complete the project. Loans can be used to bridge longer-term financing options, grant funds, or New Markets Tax Credit equity.

Credit Enhancement

Building Hope provides guarantees for facilities loans and leases to public charter schools nationwide. General terms include a guaranty period of three to five years and an annual reduction in the guaranty. Credit enhancements are supported in part by a grant from the U.S. Department of Education Charter School Program. Preference is given to schools that have been operating for less than three years and/or where at least 50% of students qualify for free or reduced-price lunch.

We have created more than 9.3 million square feet of space for charter schools, serving 135,000 students.

THE RIGHT BUILDING FOR YOUR SCHOOL

Turnkey Facility Development

Building Hope provides charter schools with custom-built facility solutions for both new construction and renovations. We manage all phases of the development process, including but not limited to:

- Strategic visioning
- Site identification and procurement
- Project financing
- Design, pre-development, and construction management

Upon completion of a building, Building Hope will lease the facility to the school for significantly less than the going commercial rate. Each lease contains a purchase option, and Building Hope works with our school clients to identify optimal financing — such as taxexempt bonds and New Markets Tax Credits — so schools can purchase their facilities.

Project Management

Our team can work with schools at any point in the process. Schools have hired Building Hope during initial planning when they are not sure where to begin, after purchasing a site, and at the completion of the design phase.

We have also worked strictly as intermediaries, managing communication between the school and the builder so that administrators can stay focused on educating students instead of attempting a crash course in the construction industry.

Everyday administrative tasks and details are as necessary to operating a charter school as they are for any business with a multimillion-dollar budget. But charter schools need to focus their time, resources, and especially staff on educating students. Building Hope Services invites you to let us manage these back-office services on your school's behalf, so you can concentrate on running a school.

SOME OF THE TASKS WE CAN TAKE ON

Accounting

We can process invoices, file financial reports with your board and authorizer, and help develop budgets. Our online portal makes it easy for schools.

Human Resources

We can process payroll, maintain staff compensation and benefits packages, and handle other HR functions.

Policy and Compliance

We'll help develop and enforce policies and procedures that comply with state and federal requirements.

National School Lunch Program

We can provide assistance with paperwork, RFPs, and verifications for free and reduced-price meal service.

Third-Party Coordination

Building Hope Services will coordinate with third-party vendors on their services, such as technology, repairs, and legal.

Grant Management

Many charter schools are fortunate to receive grant money such as the federal Charter Schools Program (CSP) grant. Building Hope can assist with the grant process, managing reimbursement requests and helping ensure the school is in compliance.

School Start-up

Opening a new school is an enormous task. Building Hope provides assistance to the founding group to successfully open.

The Charter Support Unit

The Charter Support Unit (CSU) originated in Florida as a state initiative to provide free consultation on administrative and operational needs for start-up charter schools. The state engaged Building Hope to operate the CSU. In 2018, Building Hope received a Charter Schools Program grant from the US Department of Education to expand the Unit's services to New York, Washington DC, Texas, and rural schools across the country.

Financial Advising

In addition to direct financing of building projects, we can arrange and advise schools on complex bond financing, securing the lowest rates available in the capital markets.

Since 2015, when Building Hope became licensed as a Registered Municipal Advisor, we have arranged more than \$1 billion in low-cost, tax-exempt financing for charter schools.


